

Applications for the 2025 Adult Complex Thyroid and Parathyroid Surgery (ACTPS) Focused Practice Designation (FPD) Examination are now available. **Applications will be accepted from eligible diplomates until December 13, 2024.**

The 2025 ACTPS FPD exam will be held from April 7-9, 2025, at Pearson VUE testing centers nationwide.

The purpose of this FPD is to provide transparent information to patients by recognizing surgeons who have additional surgical expertise and dedicate a significant percentage of their practice to the comprehensive care of patients with benign or malignant and functional or non-functional tumors of the thyroid and parathyroid glands.

General Requirements

Eligible applicants are expected to have successfully completed an ACGME-accredited general surgery residency and/or complex general surgical oncology fellowship training program, and be currently certified by the ABS.

There are two available pathways to achieve this designation:

- 1. Practice Pathway (non-fellowship-trained)
- 2. Training Pathway (fellowship-trained)

To be eligible for this exam, applicants must:

- be currently certified by the American Board of Surgery and in compliance with the ABS Continuous Certification Program.
- demonstrate participation in multidisciplinary care for patients with thyroid/parathyroid diseases.
- be in practice and have case logs with the requisite clinical practice requirements during a consecutive period of time proximate to the application year.
 - **Practice Pathway Requirements:** A total of 120 or more thyroid/parathyroid cases are required over 3 consecutive years. This total includes core cases and a minimum of 24 complex cases as defined by the ABS.
 - **Training Pathway Requirements:** A total of 80 cases (16 complex) within the first two years of practice following fellowship completion.
- have a currently registered full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the U.S. or Canada.
- be actively engaged and capable of performing independently the entire scope of ACTPS practice without accommodation or with reasonable accommodation.
- adhere to the <u>ABS Code of Ethics and Professionalism</u>.

If you meet the requirements for this designation as defined above, you may access the application through the *Apply & Register* page in your ABS portal:

- 1. Log in to the ABS surgeon portal.
- 2. Using the left-side menu, navigate to the *Apply & Register* page.
- 3. On the tile labeled 2025 FPD Adult Complex Thyroid and Parathyroid Surgery (ACTPS) Exam, click the link to Complete your Exam Application.

Applications must be submitted by December 13, 2024. Following approval of your application, you will be able to complete registration, submit payment for the examination, and schedule a testing center location.
